Terms and Conditions for Net Metering

- Both Host and Dependant Accounts must be on properties owned, or leased and operated, by a customer-generator. Meter aggregation on these accounts shall be limited to meters located on properties within two (2) miles of the boundaries of the customer-generator’s property.
- Shopping Accounts – The credit or compensation terms for excess electricity produced by the customer-generators, who are customers of Electric Generation Suppliers (EGS) shall be stated in the service agreement between the customer-generator and the EGS. As such, compensation for net metered generation in excess of the delivered load on the Host account will not be made on the satellite.
- Host Account Compensation – If a customer generator supplies more electricity to the electric distribution system than the EDC delivers to the customer-generator in a given billing period, the excess kilowatt hours shall be carried forward and credited against the customer - generator’s usage in subsequent billing periods at the full retail rate. Any excess kilowatt hours shall continue to accumulate until the end of the year. The customer-generator is responsible for the customer charge, demand charge and other applicable charges under the applicable Rate Schedule.
- Dependant Account Compensation – For customer-generators involved in virtual meter aggregation programs, a credit shall be applied first to the meter through which the generating facility (Host) supplies electricity to the Company’s distribution system, then through the remaining meters (Dependant) equally at each meter’s designated rate under the applicable Rate Schedule. This credit will be posted to the customer’s account. Any remaining credit not applied to the Dependant account will be paid to the customer at the end of the year. All credit amounts will be reported to the IRS.

NOTE: Although PPL Electric Utilities may provide electric service to secondary locations on a customer's property, PPL does not install new metered service for the sole purpose of transferring generation exports. Applications for the cost to provide a new service will be contingent on customer kWh usage and the delivered load from PPL Electric Utilities.

By signing this application, the customer acknowledges and agrees that operation of their generation facility is intended primarily to offset part or all of customer's electricity requirements in accordance with the Net Metering Rider. Customer further acknowledges and agrees that excessive generation by the customer's generation facility, as determined solely by PPL, is cause for disqualification for service under the Net Energy Metering Rider.
